Class Descriptions

IET Core English

Monday and Wednesday 10:00 am – 12:30 pm

In this essential course of study, students will develop speaking, listening, reading and writing skills. Activities include grammar exercises and conversational practice. Students interested in attending college, successfully running a business, or traveling in the United States will benefit from this class because it covers all language learning areas. This class runs the whole year, with different material covered in each section.

Preparing for the TOEFL *

Tuesday & Thursday 10:00 am – 12:30 pm

Students will be introduced to all aspects of the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL). Elements of each section of the test will be examined along with test-taking strategies. The materials in this course will help you to prepare for the test and also for future success in college-level coursework. Sample tests are practiced as part of this course. Students will receive leveled certificates based on their scores from the sample tests.

Writing towards Fluency

Monday & Wednesday 1 pm – 3 pm

This course will address common writing needs of international students. The American English style of writing will be practiced, including a review of paragraph and essay forms. Writing skills will include describing, making a point, supporting a point, comparing and contrasting, explaining a process, defining, reporting, arguing, and persuading. Students will finish out the course by writing a research paper with a focus on American writing-style expectations.

Presenting with a Flourish!

Tuesday & Thursday 1 pm – 3 pm

Developing an effective oral presentation is an important English skill. This class will focus on the steps involved in preparing a good oral presentation, which could later be applied to both a school and business setting. Students will have the opportunity to prepare, practice, revise, and present presentations in the cooperative atmosphere of the classroom. Students will develop presentations through the use of the computer laboratory.
