Class Descriptions

IET Core English

Monday and Wednesday 10:00 am – 12:30 pm

In this essential course of study, students will develop speaking, listening, reading and writing skills. Activities include grammar exercises and conversational practice. Students interested in attending college, successfully running a business, or traveling in the United States will benefit from this class because it covers all language learning areas. This class runs the whole year, with different material covered in each section.

Preparing for the TOEFL *

Tuesday & Thursday 10:00 am – 12:30 pm

Students will be introduced to all aspects of the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL). Elements of each section of the test will be examined along with test-taking strategies. The materials in this course will help you to prepare for the test and also for future success in college-level coursework. Sample tests are practiced as part of this course. Students will receive leveled certificates based on their scores from the sample tests.

Accent Reduction

Monday & Wednesday 1 pm – 3 pm

Have you ever been frustrated because the people around you just can't seem to understand you? This course will focus on helping you discover the areas of pronunciation you need to work on, and then providing instruction in those areas. Students will use the International Phonetic Alphabet (IPA) as a pronunciation learning tool, and will practice the use of correct word and sentence stress, intonation, tones, rhythm, and linking.

Smile: You're on Camera!

Tuesday & Thursday 1 pm – 3 pm

This project-based course is designed to improve written and oral communication skills through the exploration of various media forms. Students will learn English by reading newspapers, watching television reports and shows, and listening to the radio and podcasts. Students will also create their own newspaper, television show, and/or radio broadcast through the use of the computer lab, a video camera, and tape recorders.
