

Preparing Lebanon Youth for Career Success

For Out-of-School Youth/Young Adults

The WIOA (Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act) Program assists qualified Lebanon County out-of-school youth (ages 16-24) with a range of services and supports, including:

- Paid internships
- Assistance in finding employment
- Training for certifications, including:
 - Forklift certification
 - Welding certification
 - Certified Nurse Aide certification
- Resume writing
- Bus passes to get to work
- Mock interviewing
- Payment for High School Equivalency (HSE) testing
- Work clothing purchases
- Support in transitioning to post-secondary education and training



The WIOA Program provides case management to participants for one year and provides additional follow-up support for the following year. The WIOA Youth Program has partnerships with many Lebanon businesses, school districts, and colleges. This program is funded through SCPa Works.

Eligibility Requirements Include:

- Age 16-24
- Lebanon County resident
- Withdrawn from high school OR high school graduate with an additional "barrier" (e.g., low-income, pregnant/parenting, disability, contact with the juvenile or adult justice system, etc.)
