Dear Valued Client,

We are writing to inform you of the latest CDC guidelines regarding the timing of the COVID-19 vaccine administration as it relates to receiving other vaccinations and/or performing postoffer /annual TB surveillance testing. The CDC advises that additional vaccinations should not be given within 2 weeks prior to receiving the 1<sup>st</sup> COVID vaccine or 2 weeks after the 2<sup>nd</sup> COVID vaccine has been given. The CDC also recommends delaying PPDs or drawing IGRA blood tests for at least 4 weeks after the second COVID vaccination. In certain situations such as receiving a tetanus shot for a laceration, the benefit of giving a vaccine may outweigh the risk of observing the 2 week window. Otherwise, WORKNET providers will observe the 2 week/4 week window recommendation. We understand that these changes may cause some challenges for your business, but we are dedicated to working with you though out this process.
