COVID-19 has taught us many important lessons in personal safety, but learning about survival outdoors allows us to develop new skills while having a lot of fun. Join Naturalist Lisa Sanchez and IU13 staff at Lancaster County Park's Pavilion #11 and learn to survive in the wilds of Lancaster County. The important things in a survival situation are food, water, shelter, and fire; we will explore all of these. As part of a team, you will have the opportunity to build a shelter and a fire. You will also gather food and water from a variety of locations in the woods and learn if they would be safe to eat in a survival situation. Because finding your way is also vital to survival, you will gain confidence in your ability to use navigational tools. Using a compass is not as easy as it seems. But you will get your bearings, count your paces, look at topographic maps, and travel in correct directions. You will also practice the vital skills of teamwork, problem solving, and collaboration! To have a great day outside, please dress for the weather and bring a water bottle. Arrive ready to meet new people and work effectively to face challenges as they are presented.

### What to Bring/Wear:

- ✓ Bagged lunch, snack, and drink; filled water bottle
- ✓ **Lancaster County Park's Liability Waiver** (link will be sent to you when online registration is received)
- ✓ Dress for the weather - we will be outdoors or in a covered outdoor pavilion.
- ✓ Sturdy shoes are required each day - NO flip flops.
- ✓ Bug repellent, hat, and sunscreen are recommended.
- ✓ Any COVID-19 related instructions will be shared prior to camp.
