The purpose of the ELECT program is to provide pregnant and parenting youth with the supports they need to complete their high school education and transition successfully into employment or continue in higher education. Coordination and collaboration with school districts and community resources will enhance the ability for youth to acquire the knowledge and skills needed for present and future success.

Eligibility

Pregnant and parenting youth (male or female) up to age 21 in Lancaster and Lebanon counties that are either enrolled in school or an approved GED program.
