## IU13 Names 2023 Annie Sullivan Award Honoree

IU13 has named Kelsey Olsen as the 2023 Annie Sullivan Award recipient. Kelsey Olsen is an Autistic Support Teacher for IU13. Her classroom is located in Elizabethtown Area High School.

The award, named after Helen Keller's lifelong teacher and companion, is presented to a professional who demonstrates exemplary care for students with disabilities, and goes above and beyond their duties to help the community. The recipient is nominated by peers and selected by a committee of past award recipients. It is considered one of the highest honors given to special education professionals.

In addition to her students and community partners, Kelsey is highly regarded as an educator as exemplified by the numerous letters of support provided by coworkers, support staff, and supervisors. We are incredibly proud of Kelsey for her dedication and passion to help students, and for the example she's setting for future educators everywhere.
