

STEM and Instructional Technology



The IU13 STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) and Instructional Technology Services Team provides direct teaching and training in the areas of STEM and Instructional Technology (IT) to our IU13 special education professionals and students. This team started in 2017 and includes three program assistants specializing in Child Accounting, Data Systems (IEPWriter/ITT), and Instructional Technology, a Special Education Consultant, and three Special Education STEM teachers for our IU13 classes. The team provides information and customized instruction via workshops, coaching sessions, or hands-on direct instruction with students and teachers. STEM is an educational approach that uses Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics to guide student inquiry, dialogue, and critical thinking. STEM is also known as the Problem-Solving Design Process, a process in which students ask/research a problem, imagine/plan solutions, create an idea, test/improve, and, of course, share what they have learned.
