# IU13 Northern Education Center Highlighted

The IU13 Board of Directors December meeting was held at the new IU13 Northern Education Center in Jonestown, PA. This building was originally Jonestown Elementary School, which was dedicated in 1957, shortly after the Northern Lebanon Joint School System was created in 1952.



Before being sold to IU13 in May of 2023, the building served as an elementary school to approximately 500 students and 54 staff members, as part of the Northern Lebanon School District. The building was renovated in 1965, 1988, and 2001, and will only require limited renovations and general upkeep before opening as the IU13 Northern Education Center and serving students from Lancaster and Lebanon county school districts.

Once fully operational, the building's use is anticipated to include programming for students served by IU13. In addition, plans are underway for the building to host a Community Clothing Bank operated by the Northern Lebanon Ministerium, which is comprised of 30 churches in Lebanon County. The Clothing Bank plans to partner with the IU13 School-to-Work program and have students handle various jobs with the clothing, similar to what they do with Goodwill.
