- Each team must have at least one adult coach/chaperone to supervise team.
- Any team's alternate student(s) play at coach's discretion/decision.
- All chess sets for tournament play will be provided by IU13. Teams are encouraged to bring chess sets for use between practice rounds.
- Lunch will be provided for students and coaches/chaperones.
- Cancel by March 21 or team will be charged the registration fee.
- This event is closed to spectators.
