IU13 Names 2024 Annie Sullivan Award Honoree

Lancaster-Lebanon IU13 has named Eleanor (Kyri) Bennett as the recipient of the 2024 Annie Sullivan Award.

Bennett is a Teacher of Hearing Impaired at John Beck Elementary School in Warwick School District. Named after Helen Keller's lifelong teacher and companion, the award is presented to a professional who portrays exemplary care to students with disabilities, while going beyond the classroom to help those in the community at large. The awarded professional is nominated by his or her peers, and selected by a committee of past award recipients. It is considered one of the highest honors given to special education professionals.

Bennett's colleagues universally noted her care and commitment to each and every one of her students, as well as her collaborative efforts outside of her own classroom. Many also acknowledged her innovative techniques that foster an effective learning environment and have an impact on the community.

"Ms. Bennett has consistently demonstrated a remarkable talent for designing and implementing programs that cater to diverse populations, in and out of the classroom setting," noted a colleague. "Her inclusive approach to education goes beyond mere representation; ensuring that everyone feels welcomed, valued, and empowered to participate."
