

Adult Education Classes - Providing morning, evening, and online classes to Lancaster and Lebanon county adults, including district parents, at no cost. Offerings include supporting students in earning their high school equivalency diplomas and helping English language learners improve their fluency, gain U.S. citizenship, and strengthen their job skills.

Al Task Force - A collaborative initiative dedicated to exploring the transformative potential of Al in the K-12 educational landscape.

Autism Academy Sessions - Provides an opportunity for individuals to enhance and expand their knowledge of autism spectrum disorders and the strategies and interventions that support learning and achievement. Participants have flexibility in choosing from the multiple sessions that directly relate to their work with students.

Battery and Projection Bulbs Procurement Program - Provides a single source for all types of battery and projection lamp needs, offered at nationally leveraged and negotiated pricing levels.

Behavior Consultant/BCBA/BS Networking Group - Quarterly meetings to provide an opportunity to discuss topics pertinent to the provision of behavioral support within a variety of education settings. Target participants include district Behavior Consultants, BCBAs, and Behavior Specialists working within Lancaster-Lebanon school districts or IU13.

Bulk Fuels Procurement - Provides a volume-leveraged and professionally managed service for the purchase of bulk fuels (bio-diesel, #2 fuel oil, and gasoline).

CAFCO (Cafeteria and Food Cooperative) - Food service job-alike and food buying cooperative. Members have the opportunity to discuss cafeteria and nutrition-related issues, best practices, and the facilitation of five annual food bids.

Career Readiness Collaborative - Meetings are intended to provide district and school career ready leaders with an opportunity to stay informed of current local, state, and national education initiatives, share solutions to relevant district and school-level career readiness issues and concerns, and network and collaborate with colleagues and local partners to support and grow career readiness opportunities across the IU13 region.

Check and Connect Mentor and Prepare and Implementation - An indepth training that provides a thorough overview of the Check & Connect background, research-based intervention guide, and step-by-step implementation planning and evaluation guidelines.

Coaches Mentor Collaborative (CMC) - Connects instructional coaches to collaborate with peers; gain support from other coaches; and share issues, concerns, and solutions. Meetings include networking, professional learning, and IU13 updates.

Collaborative Purchasing Program - Provides volume-leveraged bids for both line-item supplies and catalog discounts.

Collaborative Purchasing Solutions (CPS) - A website and online marketplace providing an innovative, one-stop source for an organization's procurement needs.

Communications & Public Relations Consortium - An opportunity for districts to discuss current communications industry trends, share publicity plans, and hear from local experts about issues impacting the local community, parents, and/or staff. Participation is free and limited to Lancaster and Lebanon county public school districts.

Contract Compliance PAIU Wide Job-Alike Group - Provides a state-wide, job-alike forum for administrators responsible for organizational level contract compliance. The group shares ideas, documents and has speakers with specialized knowlege a few times a year.

Contracted Technology Services - Services include Application Development, System and Network Administrator Consultation, On-Site Network Assessments, Colocation, Virtual Server Hosting, Content Filtering, and Technology Training Services to school districts in Lancaster and Lebanon counties.

Courier Service - A delivery service to and from IU13 and among the 22 school districts in Lancaster and Lebanon counties, as well as the Career and Technology Centers, reducing the need for postage and delivery service fees for the inter-district exchanges.

Cultural Navigation Services - Helps refugee and immigrant students successfully integrate into school life in the United States. Navigators, who speak a variety of languages, work collaboratively with the family to assess current school and academic needs and goals. The navigators also offer professional development for school staff on effective ways to engage with refugee and immigrant families.

Curriculum Coordinators' Meetings - Monthly meetings for assistant superintendents, curriculum directors, and similar administrators to discuss local and state educational topics related to teaching and learning in public schools.

Custodial Supplies Program - A negotiated program which provides "just-in-time" procurement of facilities supplies and equipment.

District Human Resources Exchange - A forum for district staff to review human resources (HR) issues, best practices, certification updates, and pending HR-related legislation.

District Human Resources Exchange Conference - Offers district administrators the opportunity to discuss topics of common interest and receive in-depth information on new initiatives occurring in the human resources field.

Early Head Start, Head Start, and Pre-K Counts - Comprehensive early childhood education programs for children from birth through the transition to kindergarten. These programs are available to families based on income and other eligibility requirements.

Ed Tech Pool Counsel - Provides legal support in the ever-changing legal landscape that surrounds education technology. The pool provides proactive strategies, training, and policies designed to prevent the digital-age problems that can lead to liability.

Education Conference - An annual one-day conference that offers participants a variety of topics related to autism, literacy, transition, mathematics, technology, and many other educational subjects. The conference is open to general and special educators, administrators, school health professionals, parents, university students, and agency personnel. The presenters range from local professionals to nationally known speakers.

ELECT (Education Leading to Employment and Career Training) - Provides pregnant and parenting youth with the supports they need to complete their high school education and successfully transition into employment or higher education. Coordination and collaboration with school districts and community resources enhances the ability for youth to acquire the knowledge and skills needed for present and future success.

Electricity Procurement Program - Provides cost-effective and professionally managed services for the purchase of electricity.

Elementary & Secondary Technology Conference - An Instructional Technology Conference for K-12 teachers and administrators.

Emergency Certified Substitute Teacher Training - Training for non-certificated individuals, holding a bachelor's degree, to allow them to teach on a day-to-day substitute basis for IU13 programs and participating school districts.

Emotional Support Network - The Emotional Support Networking group is designed to provide a supportive and collaborative space for colleagues from across Lancaster and Lebanon counties to engage in discussions, share insights, and learn from each other's experiences related to emotional support practices. The group aims to review a wide range of topics relevant to the field of emotional support, including but not limited to Crisis Intervention Techniques, Emotional-Regulation Strategies, Trauma-Informed Care, Mental Health Awareness, Self-Care, Burnout Prevention, and Case Collaboration/Best Practices.

English Language Development (ELD) Leadership Collab. - A forum to give ELD leaders an opportunity to stay informed of the most current information from the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) and professional organizations, and partake in collaborative professional learning for building their own capacity to lead.

English Language Development (ELD) Professional Learning Community (PLC)

- Provides district teacher leaders with the opportunity to: discuss current information from PDE and the United States Department of Education (USDE), keep up-to-date with ELD research data, engage in professional learning opportunities, and provide input regarding district needs or the development of materials to enhance district/school capacity.

Enriched Virtual Forum - Supports district cyber academies to provide highquality academics and cost-effective programs in order to compete with other cyber charter programs available today.

ESport Collaborative - Provides IU13 Esports Managers, Coaches and Advisors with a regularly scheduled time to network with others running Esports programs to share ideas, upcoming events, games platforms and opportunities with Esports across PA.

Financial Comparison Data - Provides districts with financial information for evaluation purposes.

Flight Team - A team of district counselors, social workers, psychologists, and administrators who are trained to support districts in a time of need by providing counseling support to students and staff during a traumatic situation.

Gifted Network Meetings - Offers a network for teachers and coordinators of gifted students focusing on current topics and policies related to gifted education.

Homestead/Farmstead Applications - Provides Lancaster County school districts with a collaborative effort for the joint printing and mailing of the annual Homestead/Farmstead Applications.

Induction for Unique Roles Group - Creates specialized induction trainings for non-teaching professionals such as school psychologists, school social workers, and speech therapists to supplement traditional induction trainings.

Instructional Classroom Supplies Program - A negotiated program that provides "just-in-time" procurement of instructional classroom items.

Instructional Media Services - Provides digital media and equipment for instructional use with students, including a wide variety of subject areas and instructional levels, shared between all districts in Lancaster and Lebanon counties.

Itinerant Autistic Support Network - Quarterly meetings for itinerant teachers of students with autism to network with one another and discuss effective strategies, to consult with classroom teachers, and to work with students across classrooms.

Lancaster-Lebanon Virtual Solutions - A high-quality, cost-effective online learning solution for students in local districts.

Learning Support Network - Meetings to directly support all levels of special education learning support teachers who are providing academic and behavioral instruction to students. Sessions in this series include trainings, resource sharing, problem solving, and collaboration for fidelity of implementation.

Legislative Breakfast - An opportunity for Lancaster and Lebanon county school district administrators, school board members, and local legislators to discuss issues impacting public education.

Librarians' Collaborative - A forum for discussing current trends related to technology and media, and for sharing ideas and best practices to support librarians.

Life Skills Support Network - Meetings for Teachers to gather to share information about practices and instructional programs currently being used in their classrooms. Participants are requested to bring samples of lessons, materials, etc., to share with colleagues. They are also encouraged to develop questions in advance to participate in brainstorming solutions with the group.

Lighting Procurement and Recycling Program - A negotiated program which provides procurement of lamps and ballasts, as well as providing a recycling option for the disposal of lamps, ballasts, and batteries.

Literacy Leaders Collaborative - A forum to discuss current information from PDE and USDE, keep up-to-date on current research related to literacy, engage in professional learning opportunities, review new curriculum materials, and plan literacy events throughout the year.

LLPSIP Property Casualty Insurance Pool - Provides Property Casualty and School Leaders' Liability coverage, building appraisal services, and risk management assessments.

LLPSIP Workers' Compensation Insurance Pool - Provides Workers' Compensation coverage, including claims management, accident prevention, and other related services.

Medical Education Coalition - A forum for special education administrators and medical practitioners to discuss various topics with the goal of ensuring that medical professionals and educators work cooperatively to support students in the school setting.

MTSS Network and Sessions - The Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS) Network is designed to facilitate collaborative discussions, knowledge sharing, and professional development opportunities for members engaged in implementing MTSS within educational settings. The group aims to review a wide range of topics relevant to MTSS and provide a platform for members to discuss and learn from each other's experiences.

Natural Gas Procurement Program - Provides a cost-effective, professionally managed service for the procurement of natural gas.

Novice Autistic Support Teachers Networking Group - An opportunity for teachers and specialists new to autistic support to join from across Lancaster and Lebanon counties to learn, network, and grow. These meetings will allow discussion of topics pertinent to leading intensive autistic support classrooms. Each session allows time for participants to ask questions and network in a jobalike group.

Office Supply Procurement - A negotiated program that provides "just-in-time" procurement of office supplies.

PA Statewide Hardware Program - A negotiated program that provides technology hardware and select software

Paraeducator Academy - Annual three-day academy designed to provide training opportunities to paraprofessionals on a variety of topics related to special education and instruction. Participants are able to use the sessions to partially fulfill their 20 hour credentialling requirement.

The Pennsylvania Association of School Administrators (PASA) Dynamic Learning Map (DLM) Trainings - This training is mandatory for individuals who administer the PASA DLM and for supervisors of those who administer the PASA DLM. Total training time is 7 hours: 4 hours to be completed asynchronously via online webinars and the remaining 3 hours of training are offered in person.

Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) - Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) is an evidence based, tiered framework for supporting students' behavioral, academic, social, emotional, and mental health. It focuses on identifying, teaching, and reinforcing positive behaviors in students as well as using proactive strategies to address problematic behaviors. PBIS is based on the three-tier model of support and a refresher course.

Pennsylvania Statewide Hardware Program - Provides a negotiated program for the purchase of technology supplies and equipment.

Plant Managers' Meetings - Meetings for the plant managers of the Lancaster and Lebanon county school districts to discuss facilities-related issues and provide support as needed.

Principals' Collaborative - A forum for public school leaders who work in Lancaster and Lebanon county schools to network and collaborate around local, state, and national education topics; share solutions to school-level issues; and build capacity to lead.

Private Cloud Services - Expands and upgrades school district technology infrastructure while decreasing operational costs. IU13 Private Cloud Services provide management implementation and disaster recovery of Microsoft Exchange and directory services.

Psychologists' Network - Meetings for network group to discuss different topics relevant to Psychologists.

Pupil Services Administrators' Meetings - Network meetings for local, state, or national updates in the field of pupil services, as well as roundtable discussion and planning for local pupil services needs across Lancaster and Lebanon counties.

Safety and Security Coordinator Working Group - Assists districts in understanding the role of safety coordinators and steps needed to ensure compliance per the Act. This group was created in response to Act 44 of 2018.

School Business Officials Professional Development Program - An annual professional development program which includes: leadership and management training, in-depth information on new initiatives, and an opportunity to discuss topics of common interest.

School-Based Mental Health Professionals Peer Network Group - An opportunity for school-based mental health professionals to network across roles, including school counselors, school social workers, school psychologists, and school nurses. Local and state updates, best practices, and professional learning are provided. Meetings are held four times per year both in person and virtually. Participation is free and limited to IU13 staff and Lancaster and Lebanon county public schools.

Schoology ConnectPA - A statewide conference for Schoology users, focusing on helping participants learn how to maximize their use of Schoology for collaboration, communication, a repository of assignments, files, and assessments. This conference is for all educators including system administrators using Schoology within their schools/districts.

Special Education Consortia Services - Provides special education services for Lancaster and Lebanon county school districts.

Special Education Consultant (SEC) Network - Meetings for network group to address secondary transition practices, and provides professional development sessions relevant to coaching and consultation for SECs.

Special Education District Administrators' Meetings - Meetings for local, state, or national updates in the field of special education, as well as roundtable discussion and planning for local special education needs across Lancaster and Lebanon counties.

Statewide Discount Software Program - Provides school districts, parents, and educators across Pennsylvania with the means to procure computer software at a significantly discounted price.

STEM Leadership Collaborative - A forum to give Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) leaders an opportunity to stay informed of the most current information from PDE and professional organizations, and partake in collaborative professional learning for building their own capacity to lead.

Student Enrichment Experience (SEE) Program - Provides a variety of standardsaligned enrichment experiences for gifted and advanced students in elementary, middle, and high school.

Superintendent Secretaries' Meetings - An opportunity for district networking, and a forum for discussion regarding educational initiatives and updates.

Superintendents' Advisory Council - Meetings for ongoing professional dialogue about local, state, and national educational matters.

Superintendents' Study Council - Annual event providing an opportunity for Lancaster and Lebanon county superintendents to gather and study successful school districts, programs, and leaders, with the goal of bringing home experiences to reinvent learning within our local school districts.

Tech Media Integrators' Collaborative - A forum for IU13 and district representatives who work with library/media resources, and the integration of technology into the K-12 curriculum. The group discusses current trends related to technology and media, and shares ideas and best practices.

Tech Talk Live - A conference that focuses on the day-to-day issues that technology professionals face in the educational environment. The intended audience includes system administrators, network administrators, help desk support, etc.

Technology Coordinators' Meetings - A forum for districts to highlight and discuss their efforts to advance technology.

Telephony Services Procurement Program - A negotiated Master Agreement with a national supplier which allows districts to purchase and lock in their long-term telephone services at very competitive pricing.

Training and Consultation - The IU13 TaC Team provides training and consultation services which are federally funded through the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA) and are available to all public school entities. The TaC Team provides information and customized training/consultations via workshops on site in school districts and at the IU13 Lancaster and Lebanon county offices.

Training and Networking for Internal Autistic Support Coaches - Program provides resources and trainings to staff working in intensive autistic support classrooms.

Transition to Post-Secondary Fair - Students in grades 9-12 with 504 Plans and IEPs, parents, and educators attend the Transition to Post-Secondary Education Fair to learn about making successful transitions to post-secondary education. Representatives from 33 colleges, universities, trade schools, agencies, and financial supports were in attendance to answer questions regarding post-secondary education.

Transportation of Students with Special Needs - A centralized routing to transport students assigned to classes outside of district borders.

Virtual Teacher Collaborative - Meetings to provide school district virtual educators with a forum to collaborate and share best practices for teaching in a solely online environment. These collaborative meetings focus on participant needs and professional development supporting K-12 online learning.

Wide Area Network (WAN) Consortium - Provides connectivity between schools and to the Internet to encourage collaboration, distance learning, resource sharing, and high-speed Internet access with available content filtering to students and staff, while off-loading firewall configuration and network management from school staff.




