2024-25 Outcomes



Hard Work Pays Off



Approximately 2,000 adult learners reported for registration/classes.



65% of post-tested students moved up at least one National Reporting System (NRS) level. Each NRS level is equivalent to two K12 grade levels.



52 improved their digital literacy and computer skills.



Over 80% of learners obtained an employment outcome.
