ATTEND is an IU13-operated mental health chronic absence intervention. The program is built upon evidence-based strategies. Students with school refusal behaviors receive a comprehensive evaluation that assesses, diagnoses, and identifies the cause(s) of the school refusal behaviors.

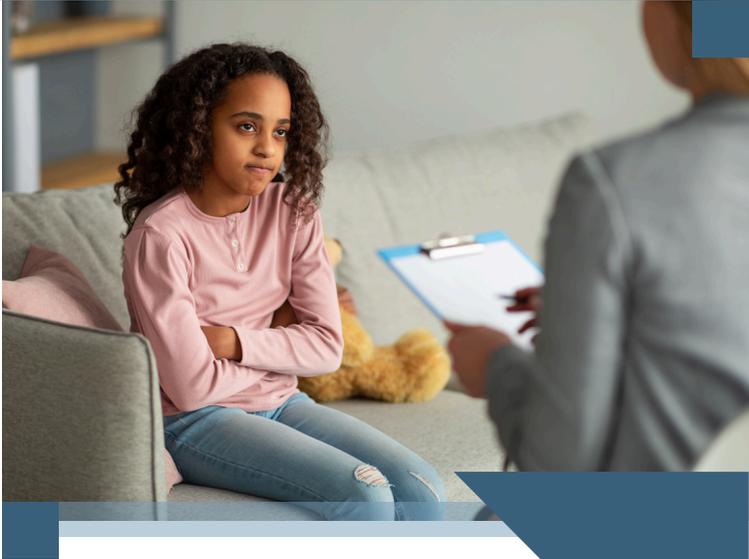

OUR SERVICES

Students experiencing school refusal behaviors are displaying symptoms of a greater need. ATTEND aims to identify that need, provide information about anxiety, regulation, and teach management strategies. ATTEND professionals help identify and engage all accessible resources.

- Psychologist**
Our school psychologist completes a comprehensive psychological evaluation and functional behavioral assessment of school refusal behaviors to inform recommendations.
- Social Worker**
Acting as a case manager, provides efficient communications, facilitates meetings, provides support, and gives referrals as needed.
- Mental Health Worker**
Professional who works with child and family in the home or school.



- Collaboration**
Our specialists work collaboratively with parents, school districts, and agencies.
- Child Interventions**
Our Mental Health Workers are knowledgeable in evidenced-based therapeutic strategies: trauma-informed care, CBT, DBT, and SPACE.
